INCOME REQUIREMENTS

The total gross monthly income of all household members may not exceed the amounts shown in the chart below. This income requirement is in place to ensure that ACSI's services effectively serve the disadvantaged citizens of Lake County. This income chart may not apply for seniors who receive Meals on Wheels, as their Senior status makes them eligible for our services.

WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THIS FREE SERVICE?

This is a free delivery service for seniors in Groveland, Florida (although donations are welcome). **There is a charge for the meals** unless you are approved for a scholarship through ACSI or First United Methodist Church. To be approved for a scholarship, you must request it and prove hardship or poverty status. Hot meals are prepared by First United Methodist Church in Clermont, Florida. We apologize, but FUMC does not provide vegetarian or meals with dietary restrictions. **The meals will be delivered Monday, Tuesday and Thursday between 11:00AM – 12Noon.** On Tuesday, you may receive additional food from Second Harvest Food Bank which consist of 1 box of 7 breakfast meals and 1 box of 7 lunch meals.

The driver's name is Monroe Richardson and drives a 15-passenger van with Anointed Community Services logo on the side. He should always be wearing a "Give Generously" T-shirt.
